NOTICE OF MODIFICATION ORDER

WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981 DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT OF RIGHTS OF WAY FOR SHROPSHIRE AND DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT OF RIGHTS OF WAY FOR POWYS

THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (RESTRICTED BYWAY ADDITION, TOWN OF BISHOP'S CASTLE, SHROPSHIRE AND COMMUNITY OF CHURCHSTOKE, POWYS) MODIFICATION ORDER 2018

The above named Order made on 1st November 2018, by The Shropshire Council ("the Council") if confirmed as made, will modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by:-

adding a Restricted Byway in the Town of Bishop's Castle, Shropshire, from point A on the order map (SO 3061 8998) at the termination of the surfaced county road, running in a general north westerly direction as a hedged lane then gradually turning to run generally westerly followed by a general west-south-westerly direction passing through woodland and continuing to cross the county boundary into Powys. The route continues in the Community of Churchstoke, Powys, as a hedged lane in a general north westerly followed by west-north-westerly direction to meet the surfaced county road at point B on the order map (SO 2952 9050). The route has a total distance of approximately 1313 metres; 848 metres in the County of Shropshire and 465 metres in the County of Powys. The route has a width varying between 4 and 8 metres.

If no representations or objections are duly made to the Order, or to any part of it, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Council, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State (or part of it if the Council has by notice to Secretary of State so elected under paragraph 5 of Schedule 15 to the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981) may itself confirm the Order (or that part of the Order). If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs in whole or in part, any representations and objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.
