a. Transport and connectivity

Update from Job Bubb:

Comments on the draft LCWIP Oswestry appendix have been fed back. The priority six schemes identified within the LCWIP phase 1 are to be considered as part of a feasibility and optioneering study to work up preliminary designs and deliver the public consultation. Rose has asked if a small group of FOG reps would act as the sounding board for this piece of work to be undertaken by consultants.

Met with Andy Evans (SC Network Solutions Team Manager) to discuss SC's current contractual arrangements for the maintenance of the bus station and opportunities for BID or OTC to provide additionality.

b. High Street Heritage Action Zone

Update from Sam Jones:

Capital Grant Programme

- Building on Willow Street work complete on new signage.
- Passed signage grant for building on Bailey Street.
- Red Lion application for new windows has passed.
- Work is progressing well on building on Cross Street. There are 6 x 2 and 1 bed flats going in. They are now fitting bathrooms, etc.
 Work to connect the building with BT lines has begun. Swift nest boxes have been installed. Work is due to begin on the shop fronts once the remaining services have been completed.
- We have had some interest again and just seeing what we can accommodate now we know other schemes will not be coming forward.
- Visited building on Willow Street and we are working on an application for a 4 bed apartment there and work to the exterior.
 We are just awaiting a structural engineers report before we continue so we can add in any works needed as part of that report.
- Writing Comms for the completed pieces of work.

Public Realm

- Clawdd Du We have a resolution concerning the alley that will still allow pedestrian access but will stop bins being able to be stored there.
 We are working with highways on the next stage and will notify affected businesses soon.
- Metal elements are still not in and just waiting to hear when we can expect installation.
- We are also just chasing up some small outstanding things such as cleaning and sealing of the paving and gates to the works.
