THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (FOOTPATH ADDITION, PARISH OF ADDERLEY) MODIFICATION ORDER 2018

This Order is made by The Shropshire Council ("the Council") under section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to the Council that the Shropshire Definitive Map and Statement require modification because in accordance with the provisions of Section 53(3)(c)(i)and(ii) the Council has discovered evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows -

that a right of way which is not shown on the map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates, being a right of way such that the land over which the right subsists is a public path, a restricted byway or, subject to section 54A, a byway open to all traffic

The Council have consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which this Order relates.

The Council hereby order that:-

- For the purpose of this Order the relevant date is 1st June 2018
- 2. The Shropshire Definitive Map and Statement shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the Order.
- This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as The Shropshire Council (Footpath Addition, Parish of Adderley) Modification Order 2018.

Description of path or way to be added

Footpath Addition, Parish of Adderley

A Footpath to be added from the County boundary at point A on the Order Map (SJ 6629 4025) at a junction with the County Road and Bridleway 10 Adderley, running in a general north-north-easterly then east-north-easterly direction following a driveway to Pool House where it crosses the yard and runs between buildings passing through a gate (SJ 6648 4042) then continues across a pasture field to Adderley Pool Bridge over the Shropshire Union Canal where there is access to the canal towpath. The path then passes through a gate (SJ 6656 4052) where it turns to run in a general northerly direction across an arable field to point B on the order Map (SJ 6655 4075), a distance of approximately 645 metres. From here the route splits and a western arm of the path continues in a general northerly direction through a field boundary via a gate (SJ 6655 4099) to become a field edge path running to point C on the Order Map (SJ 6647 4122) at the County boundary and a junction with Footpath 6 in the Parish of Audlem, Cheshire, a distance of approximately 490 metres. From point B an eastern arm of the path runs in general north-north-easterly direction through a field boundary via a gate (SJ 6661 4099) and runs to point D on the Order Map (SJ 6678 4134) at the County boundary and a junction with Footpath 10 in the Parish of Audlem, Cheshire, a distance of approximately 655 metres. The path is a total distance of approximately 1790 metres with a width of 2 metres throughout.



The path is a total distance of approximately 1790 metres with a width of 2 metres throughout.
