The above order was made on 11th April 2024. The effect of the order will be to divert.

- 1. The full width of that part of FP 122 leaving the junction of BW 124/125 (Greenfoot Lane) at point A on the Order map at grid reference SJ 5436 4050 running in a general WNW direction to point B on the Order Map at grid reference SJ 5434 4051. A total distance of approximately 26 metres and the full width of that part of FP 122 leaving point D on the Order map at grid reference SJ 5423 4057 running in a general NNW direction to point E on the Order map at grid reference SJ 5422 4064. A total distance of approximately 81 metres onto a line leaving the junction of BW 124/125 (Greenfoot Lane) at point C on the Order map at grid reference SJ 5436 4049 running in a general north westerly direction on a 2-metre-wide surfaced path to re-join the Definitive line of FP 122 at point B on the Order map at grid reference SJ 5434 4051. A total distance of approximately 25 metres and leaving FP 122 at point D on the Order map at grid reference SJ 5423 4057 running in a general northerly direction along a 2-metre-wide surfaced path to join the adopted cycleway at point F on the Order map at grid reference SJ 5423 4065. A total distance of approximately 84 metres.
- 2. The full width of FP 123 leaving its junction with FP 128 at at point A on the Order map at grid reference SJ 5443 4029 running in a general NNW direction to BW 125 at point B on the Order map at grid reference SJ 5435 4048. A total distance of approximately of 213 metres onto a line leaving its junction with FP 128 at point A on the Order map at grid reference SJ 5443 4029 running in a general NNE direction along the inside boundary of the public open space, then in a general north westerly then northerly direction over the public open space to join the highway, crossing over the highway and continuing in a general WNW direction along a 2 metre wide surfaced path, alongside the highway to re-join BW 125 at point C on the Order map at grid reference SJ 5428 4040. A total distance of approximately 236 metres with a width of 2 metres throughout its length.
- **3.** The full width of that part of FP 127 leaving point A on the Order map at grid reference SJ 5414 4021 running in a general SSW direction to point B on the

Order map at grid reference SJ 5412 4015. A total distance of approximately 60m metres **onto a line** leaving point A on the Order map at grid reference SJ 5414 4021 running in a general southerly then WSW direction on a 3-metrewide surfaced path to point B on the Order map at grid reference SJ 5412 4015. A total distance of approximately 71 metres.

4. The full width of that part of FP 128 leaving point A on the Order map at grid reference SJ 5426 4034 running in a general WNW direction to join with BW 125/BW 126 at point B on the Order map at grid reference SJ 5424 4034. A total distance of approximately 22 metres onto a line leaving point A on the Order map at grid reference SJ 5426 4034 running in a general north westerly direction on a 2-metre-wide surfaced path to re-join BW 125 at point C on the Order map at grid reference SJ 5425 4036. A total distance of approximately 24 metres.
