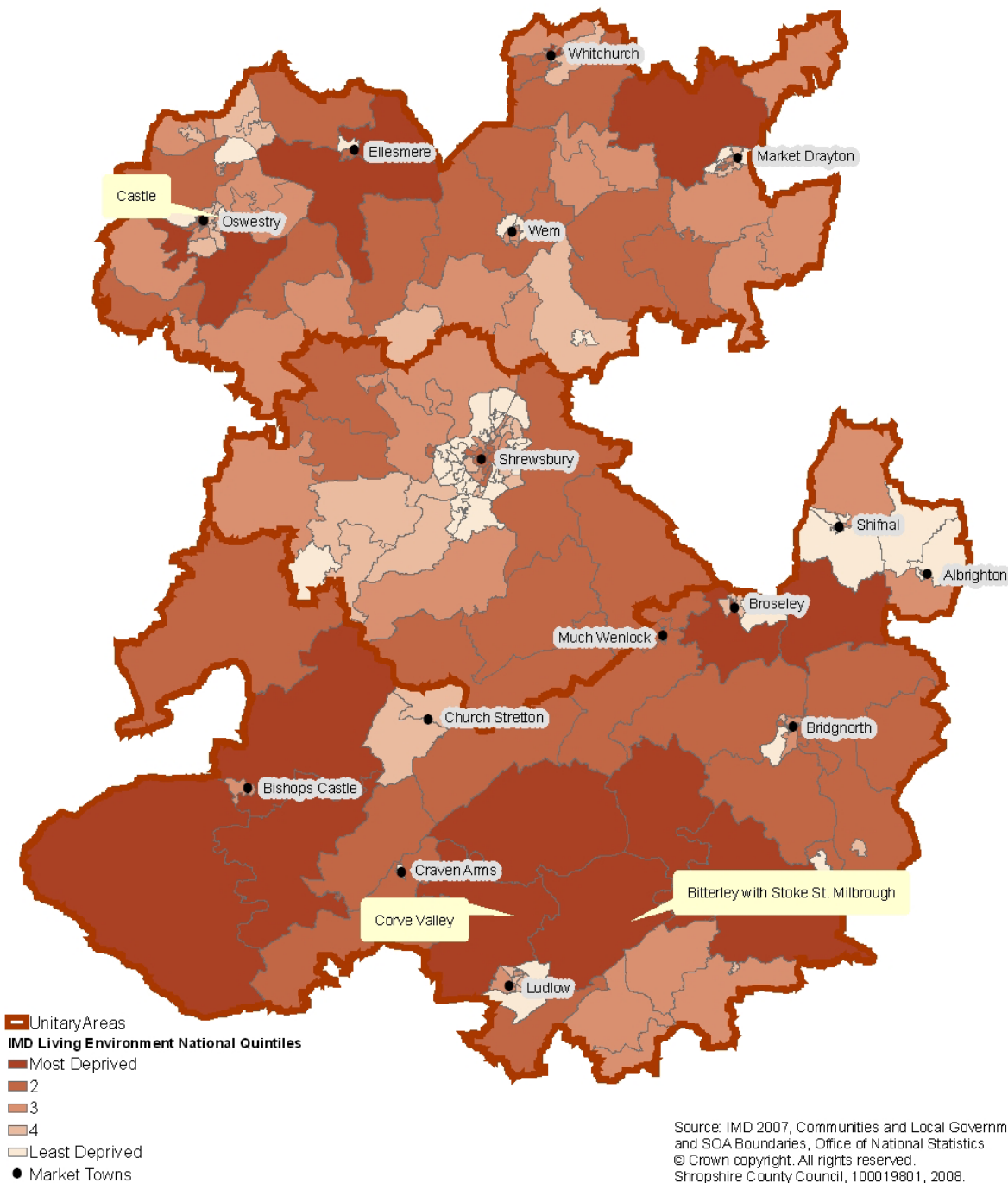

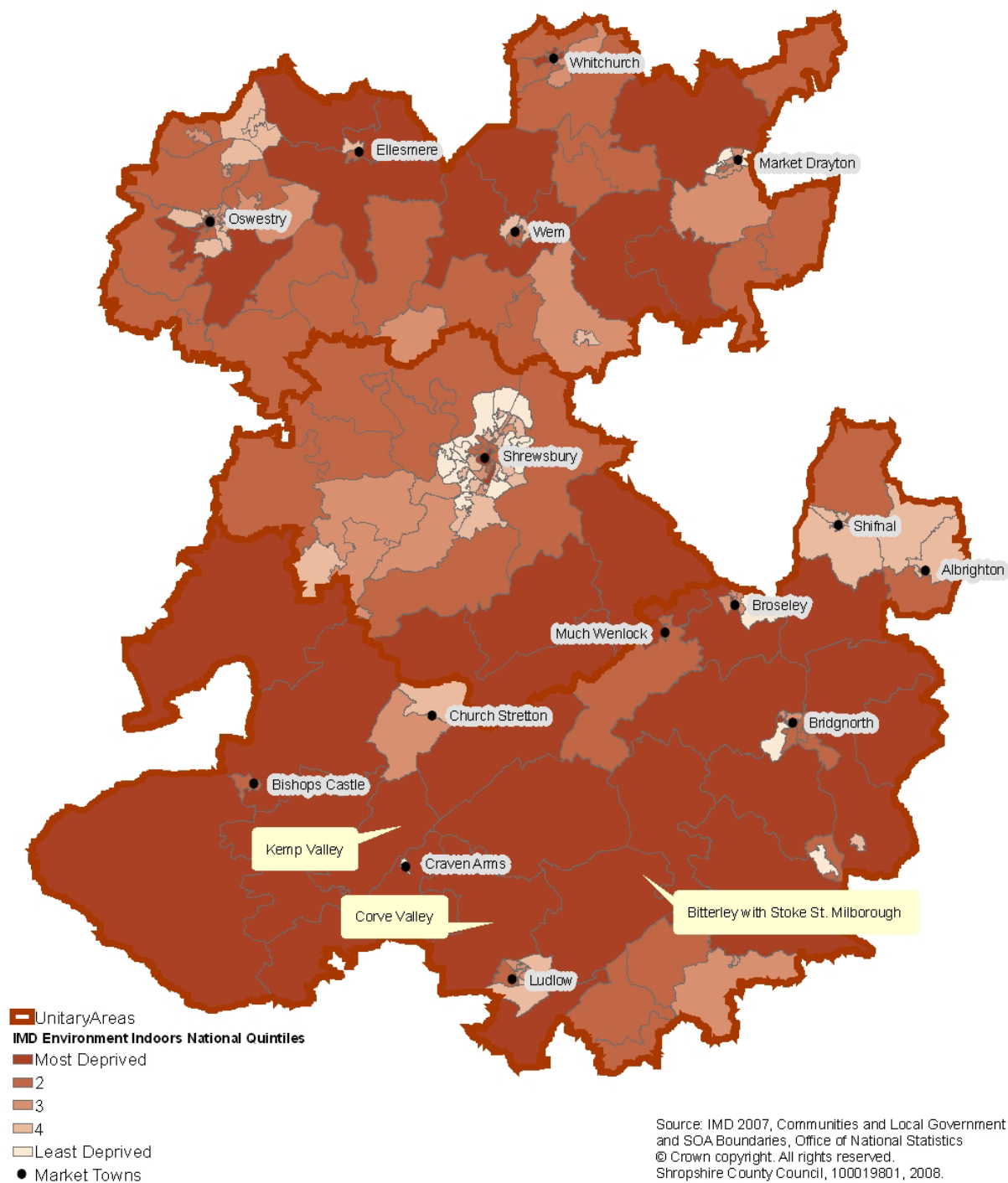

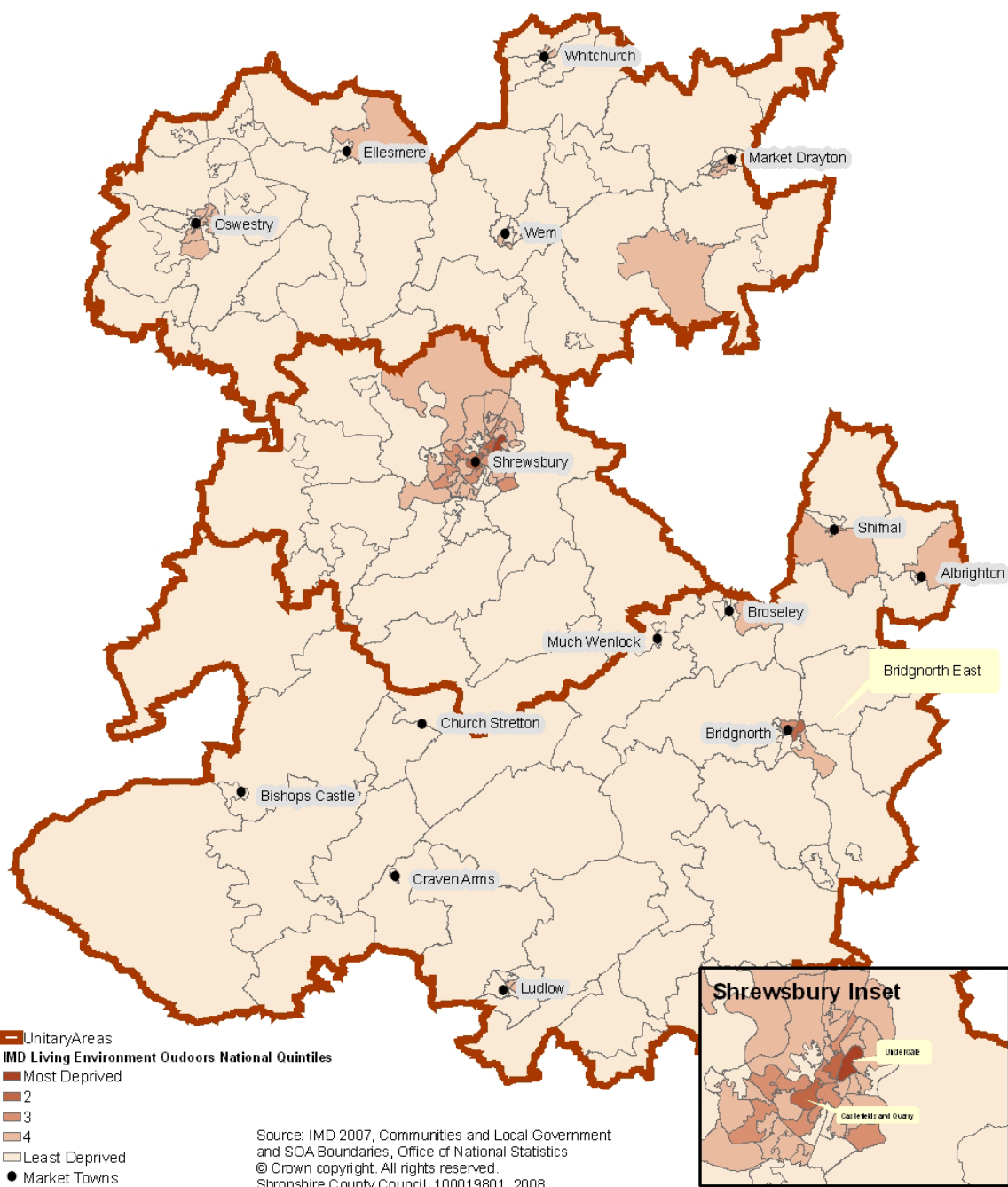

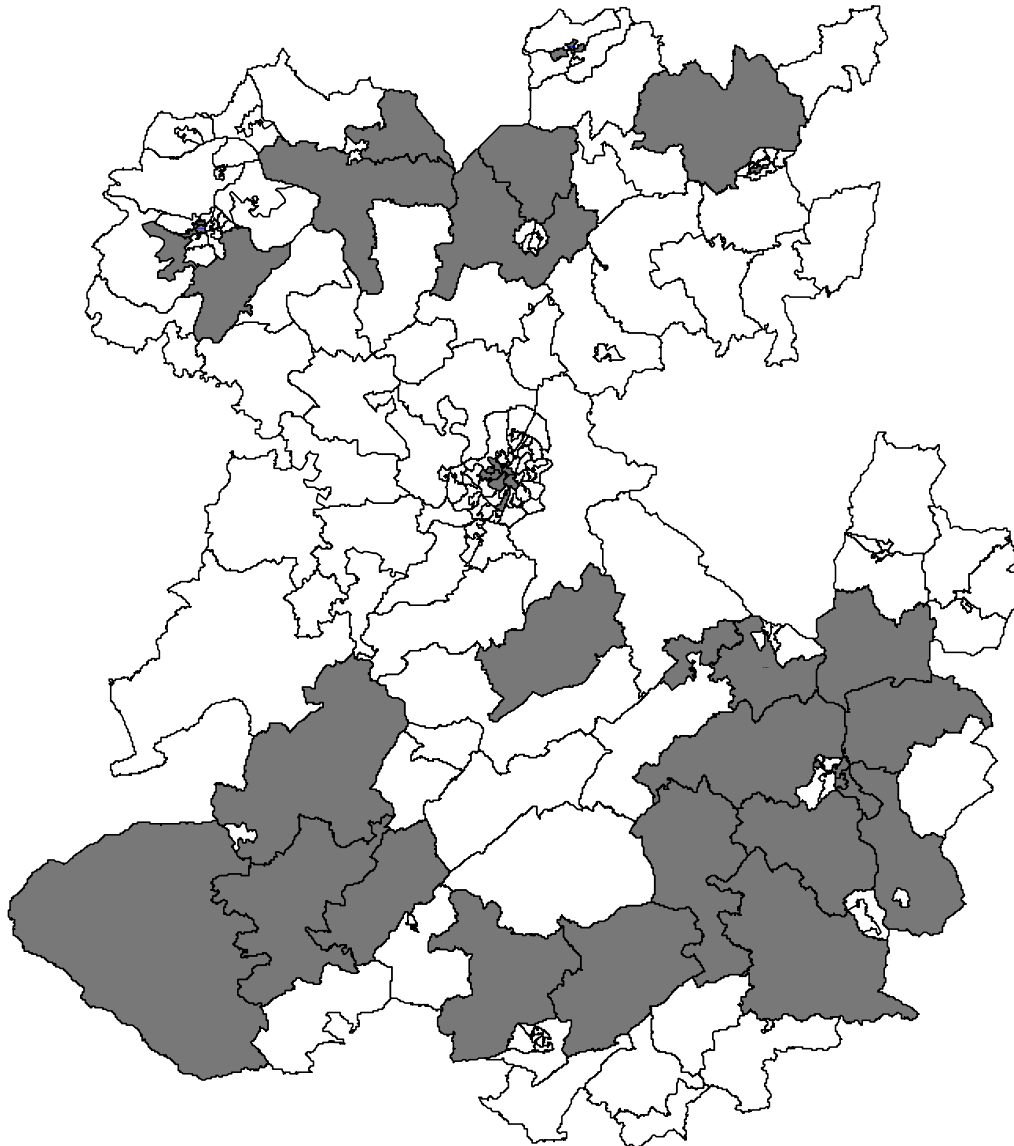

Top 20% Super Output Area's (SOA's) most deprived in Shropshire



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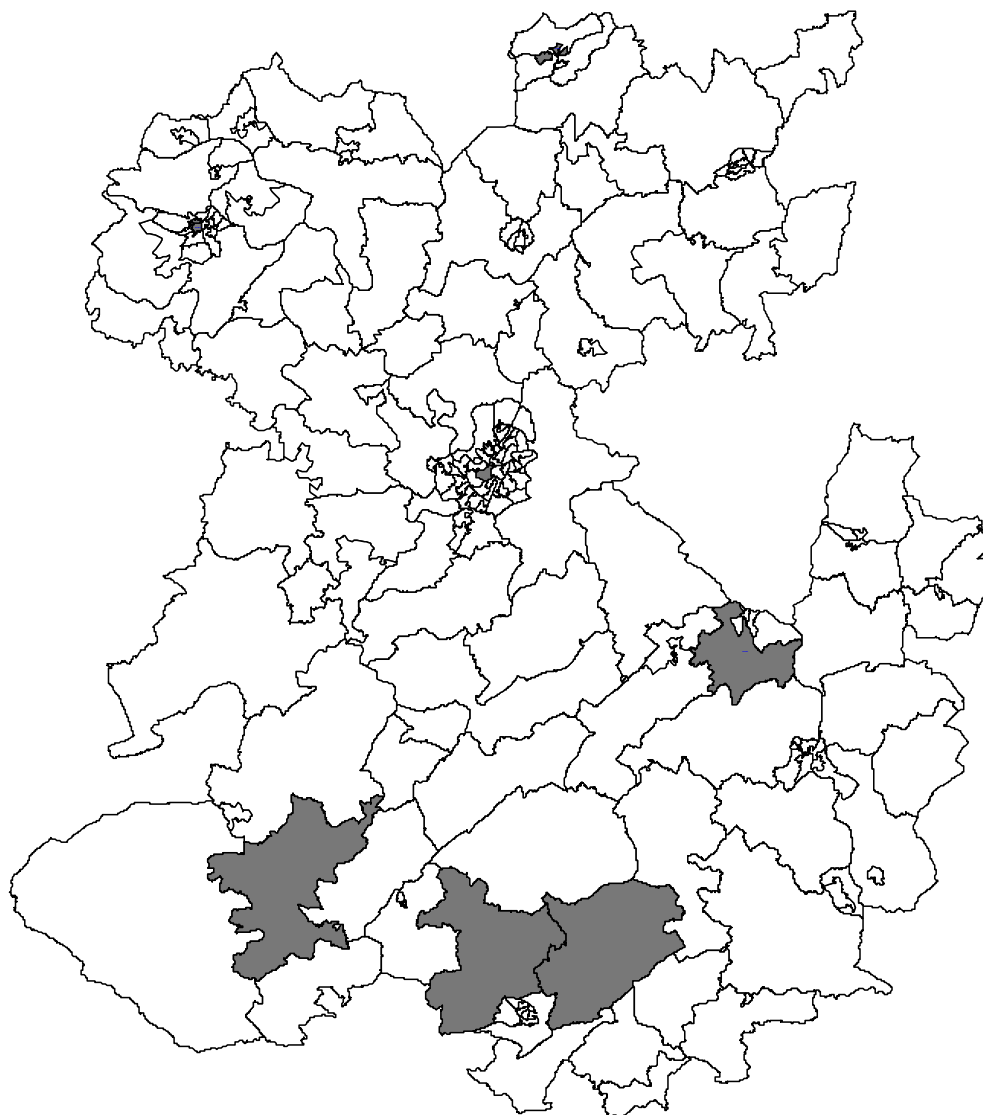

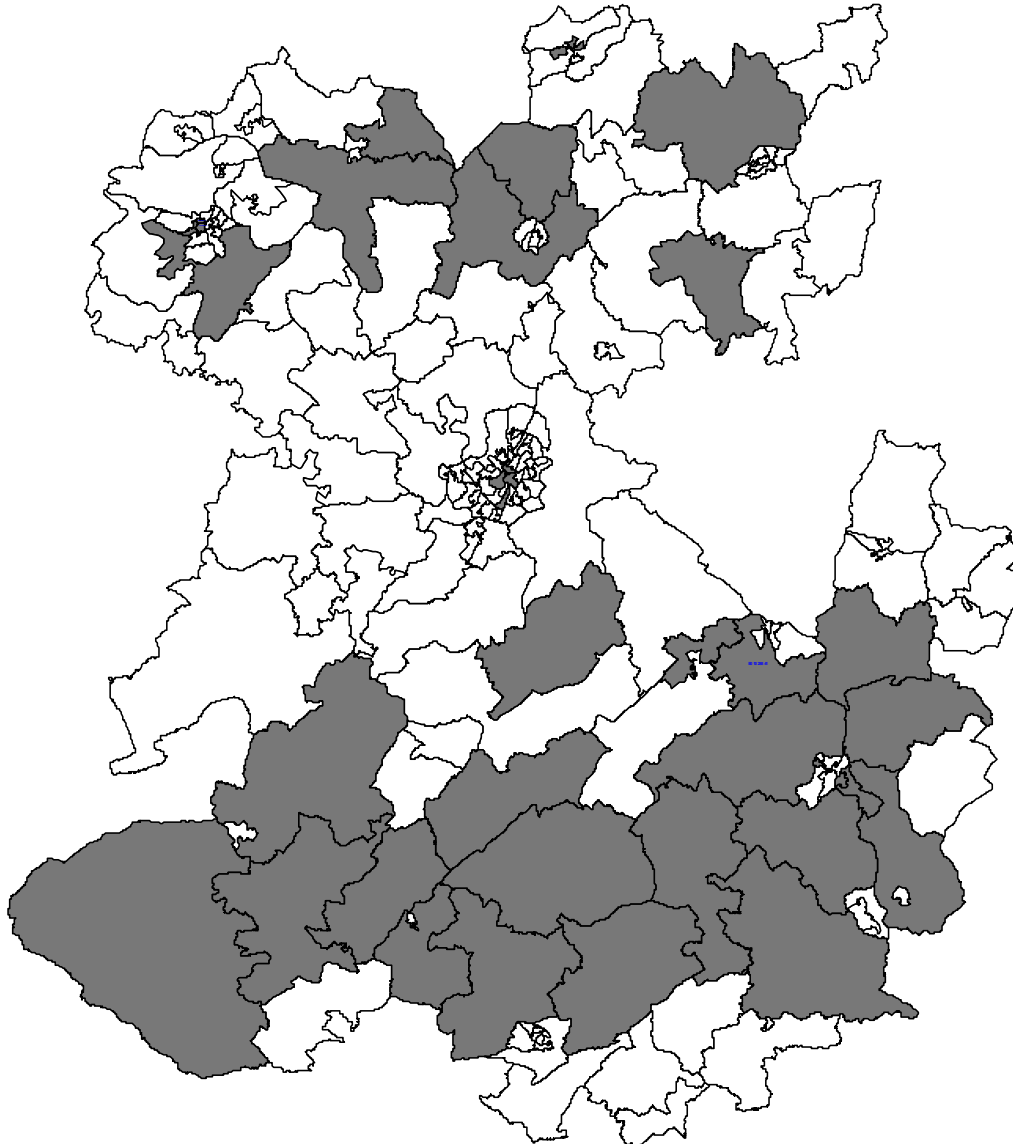

Top 20% Super Output Area's (SOA's) most deprived in *Shropshire*



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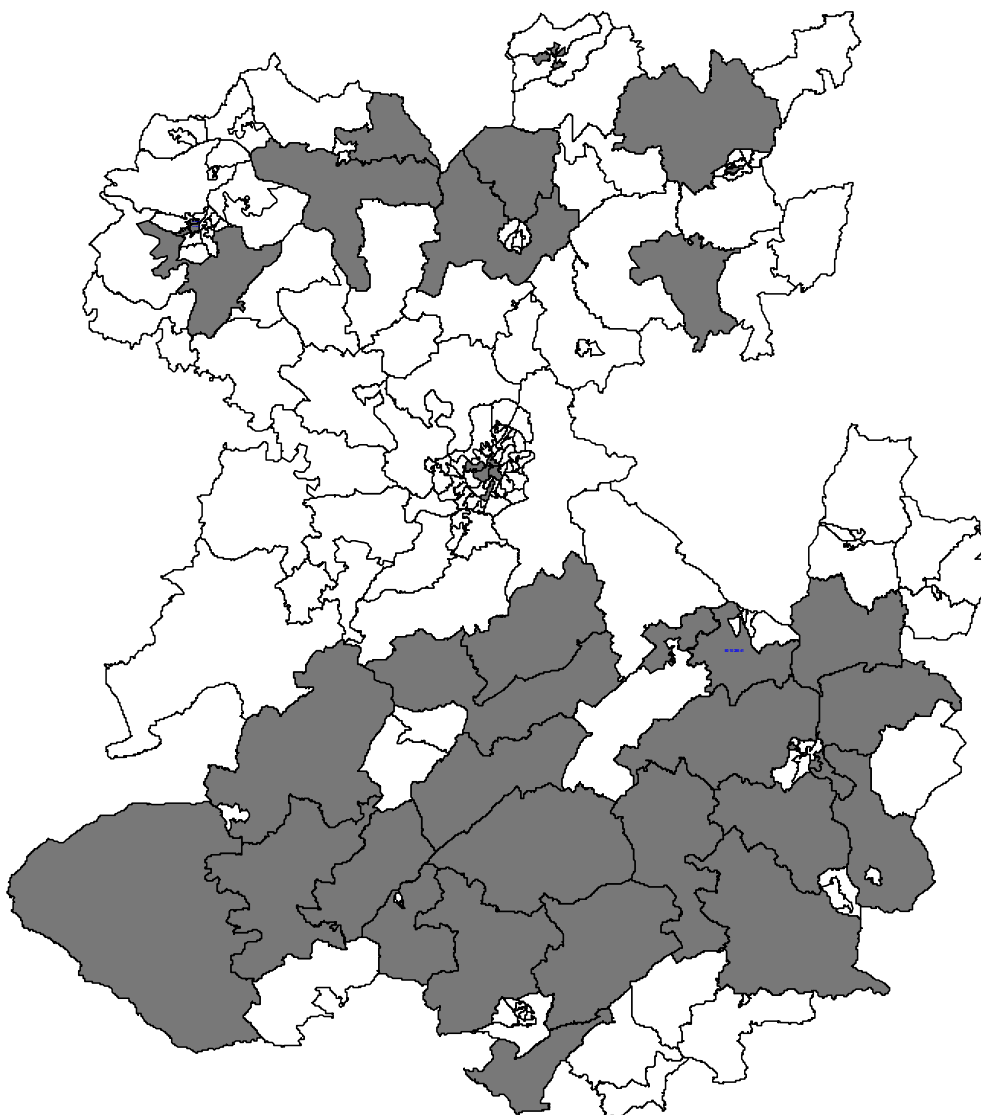
