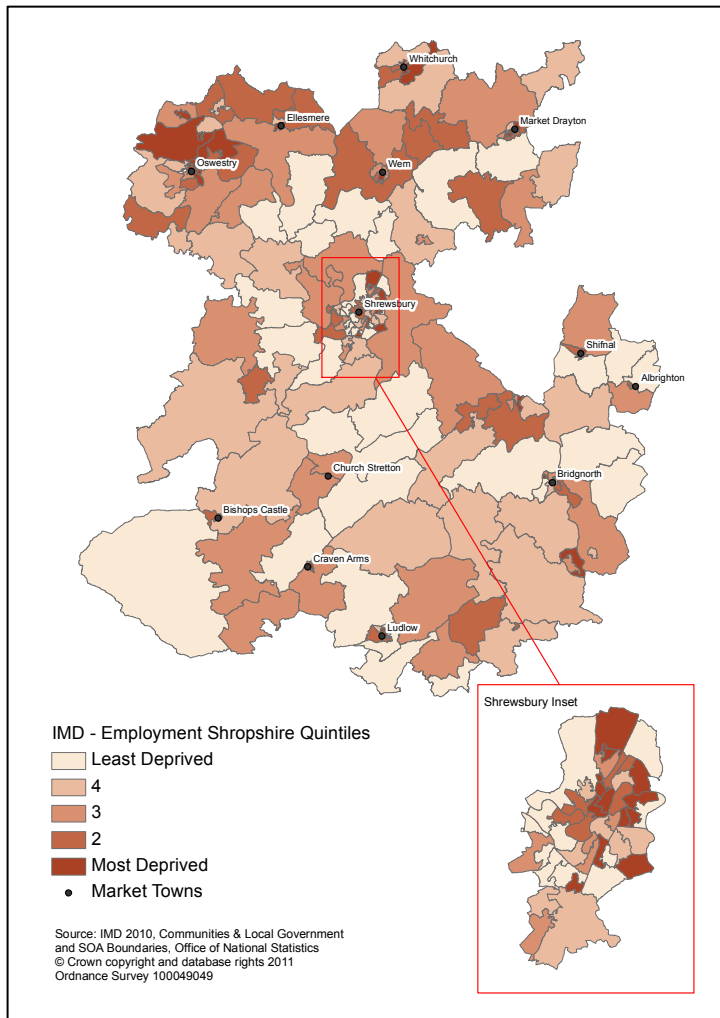


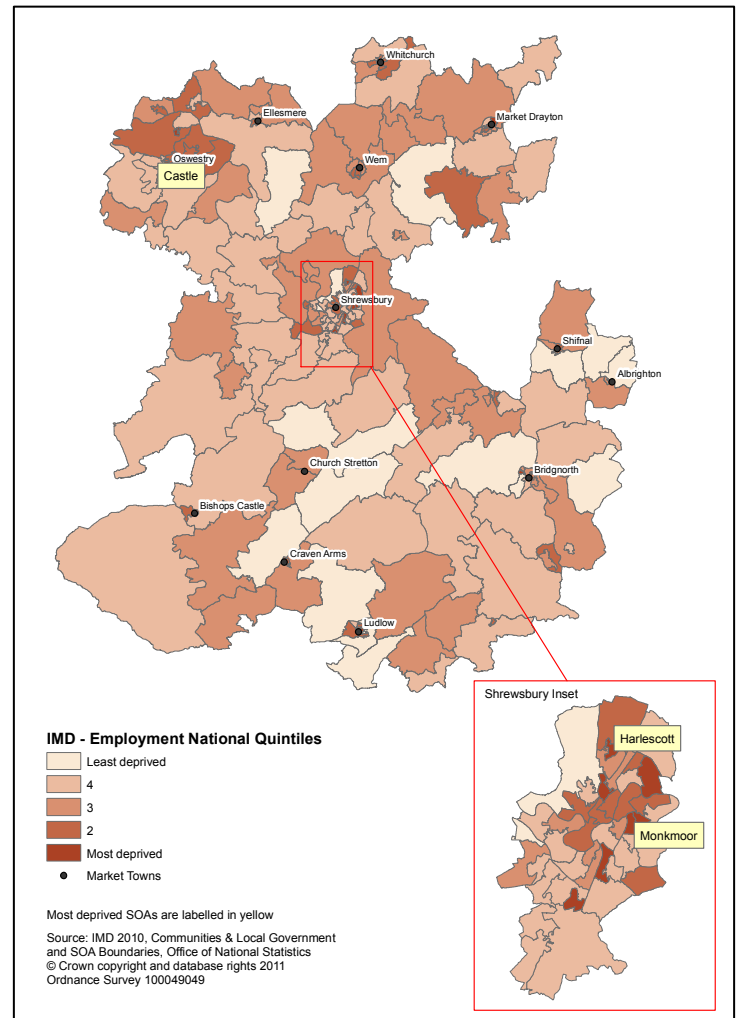

### Employment Deprivation

The employment domain is also considered to be one of the most important facets of deprivation and is weighted at 22.5%. This domain measures the percentage of the working age population who want to work but are unable to do so due to unemployment, sickness or disability. Six indicators were used to calculate the employment deprivation scores:

- Claimants of Jobseeker's Allowance (both contribution based and income-based), women aged 18-59 & men aged 18-64.
- Claimants of Incapacity Benefit aged 18-59/64
- Claimants of Severe Disablement Allowance aged 18-59/64
- Claimants of Employment Support Allowance aged 18-59/64 (those with a contribution based element)
- Participants in New Deal for 18-24s who are not claiming Jobseeker's Allowance
- Participants in New Deal for 25+ who are not claiming Jobseekers Allowance.
- Participants in New Deal for Lone Parents aged 18 and over (after initial interview).

Shropshire has 6 LSOA's which fall within the 20% most deprived nationally. 8.2% of Shropshire's population is employment deprived and this figure is slightly higher than that reported from the 2007 IMD results. In Shropshire the levels of people who are involuntarily out of work ranges from 3% to 22% within Shropshire SOAs.

An SOA within the former district ward of Harlescott has the highest deprivation levels in Shropshire.

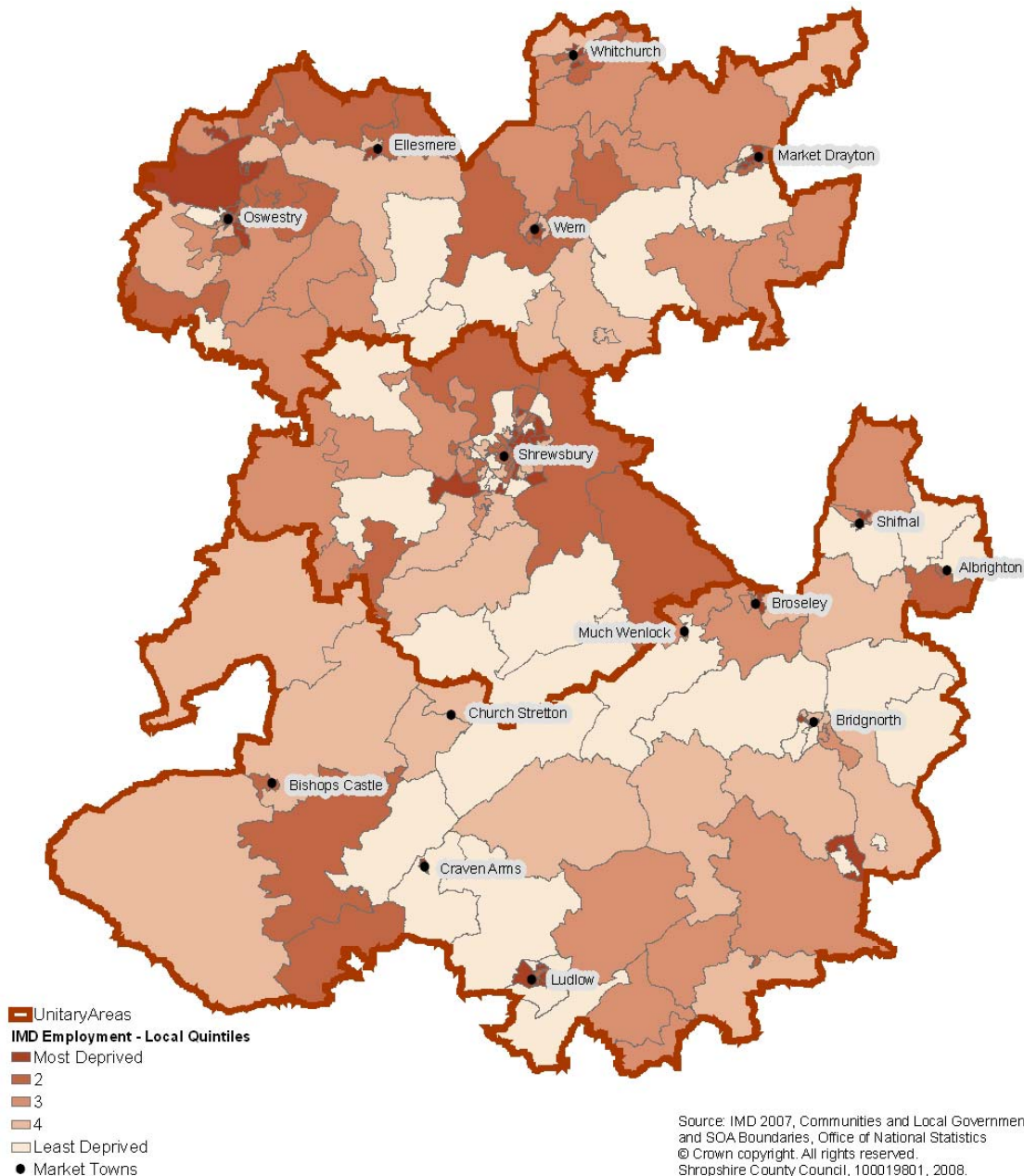

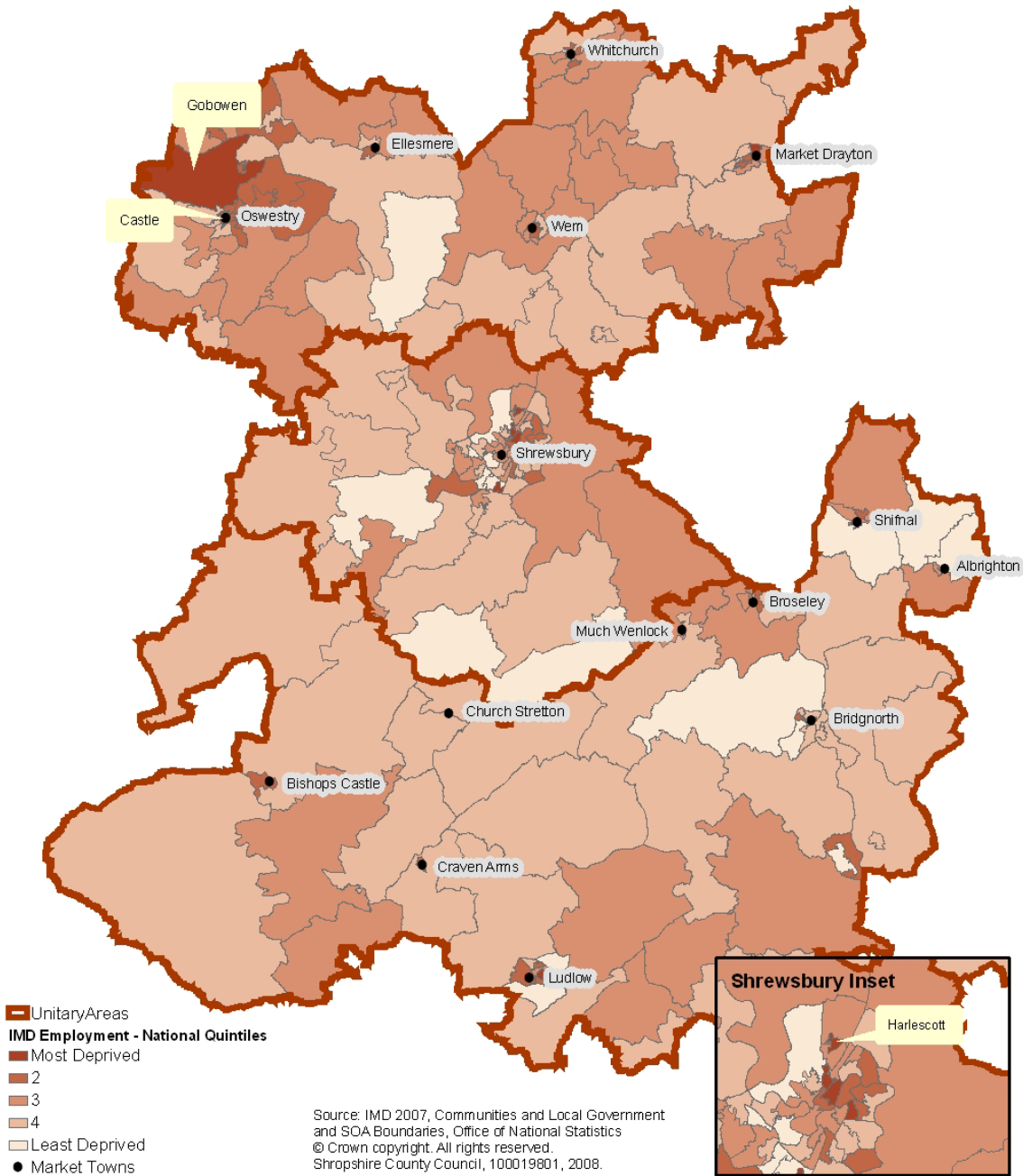

- Severe Disablement Allowance recipients aged 18-59 (women) and 18-64 (men)

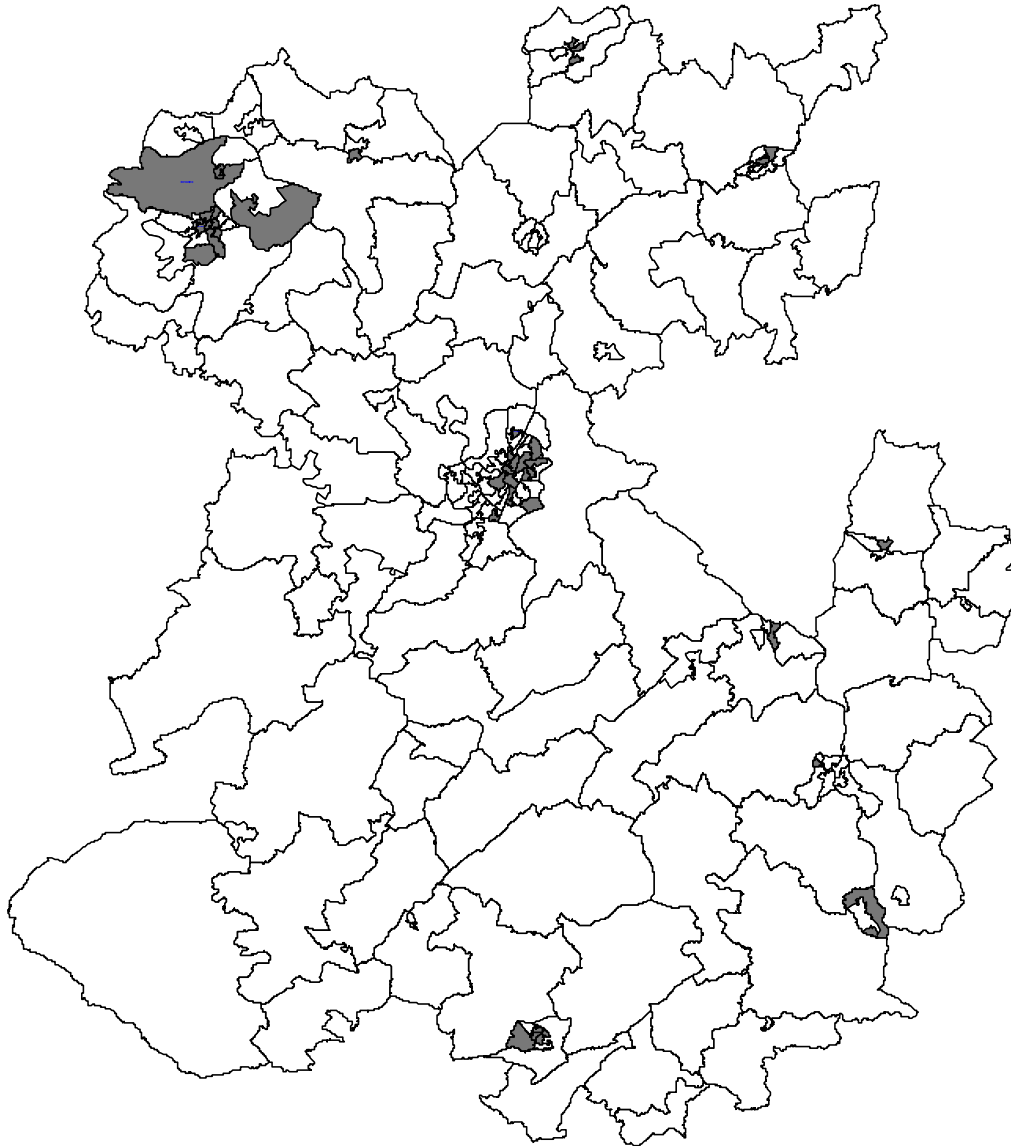

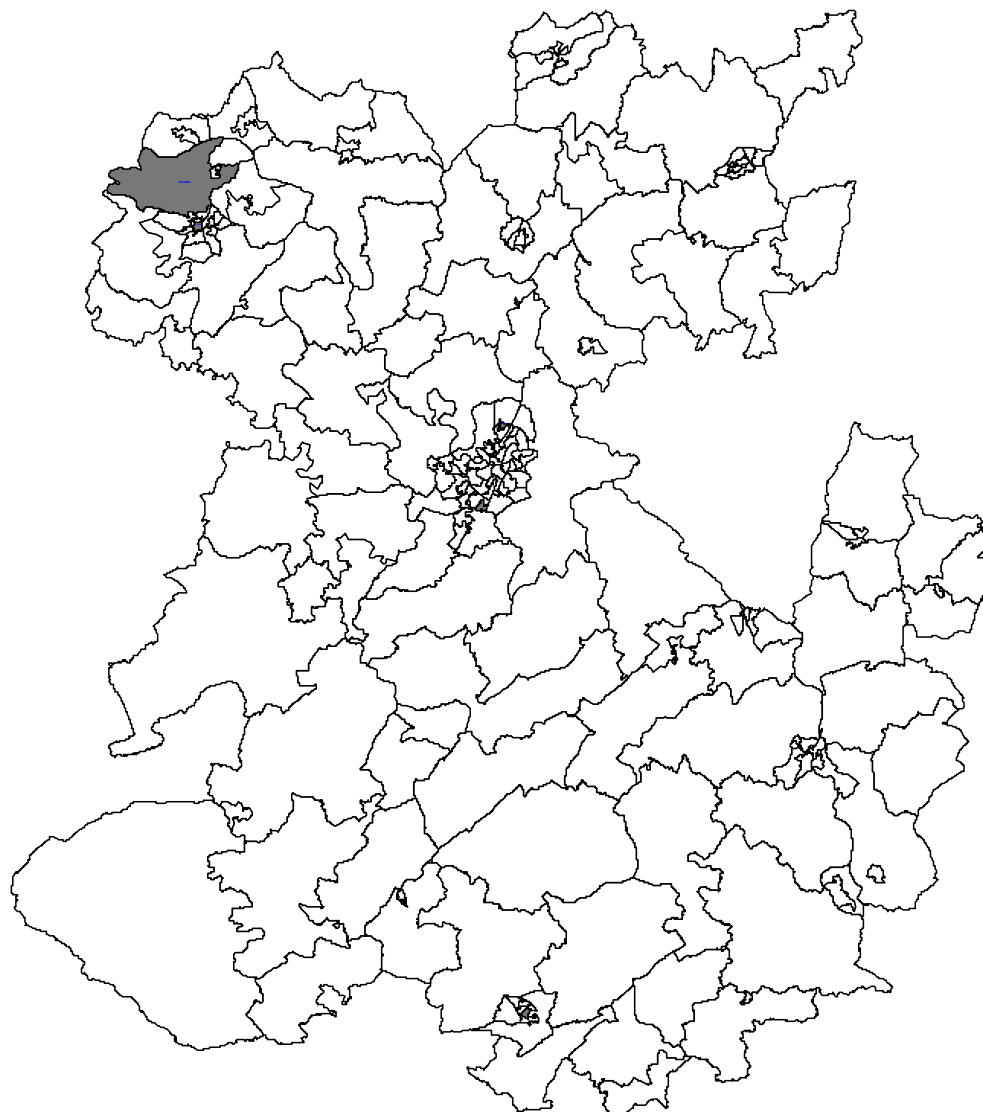

Employment deprivation is calculated using a number of indicators:

- Unemployment claimant count (JUVOS) of woman aged 18-59 and men aged 18-64 averaged over 4 quarters (2001)
- Incapacity Benefits claimants woman aged 18-59 and men aged 18-64 (2001)
- Serve Disability Allowance claimants woman aged 18-59 and men aged 18-64 (2001)
- Participants in New Deal for the 18-24s who are not included in the claimant count (2001)
- Participants in the New Deal for 25+ who are not included in the claimant count (2001)
- Participants in the New Deal for Lone Parents aged 18 and over (2001)

The IMD score for employment deprivation contributes 22.5% of the overall IMD score for each SOA.

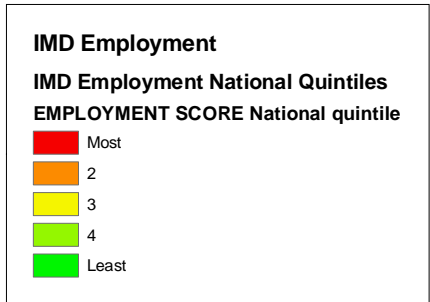
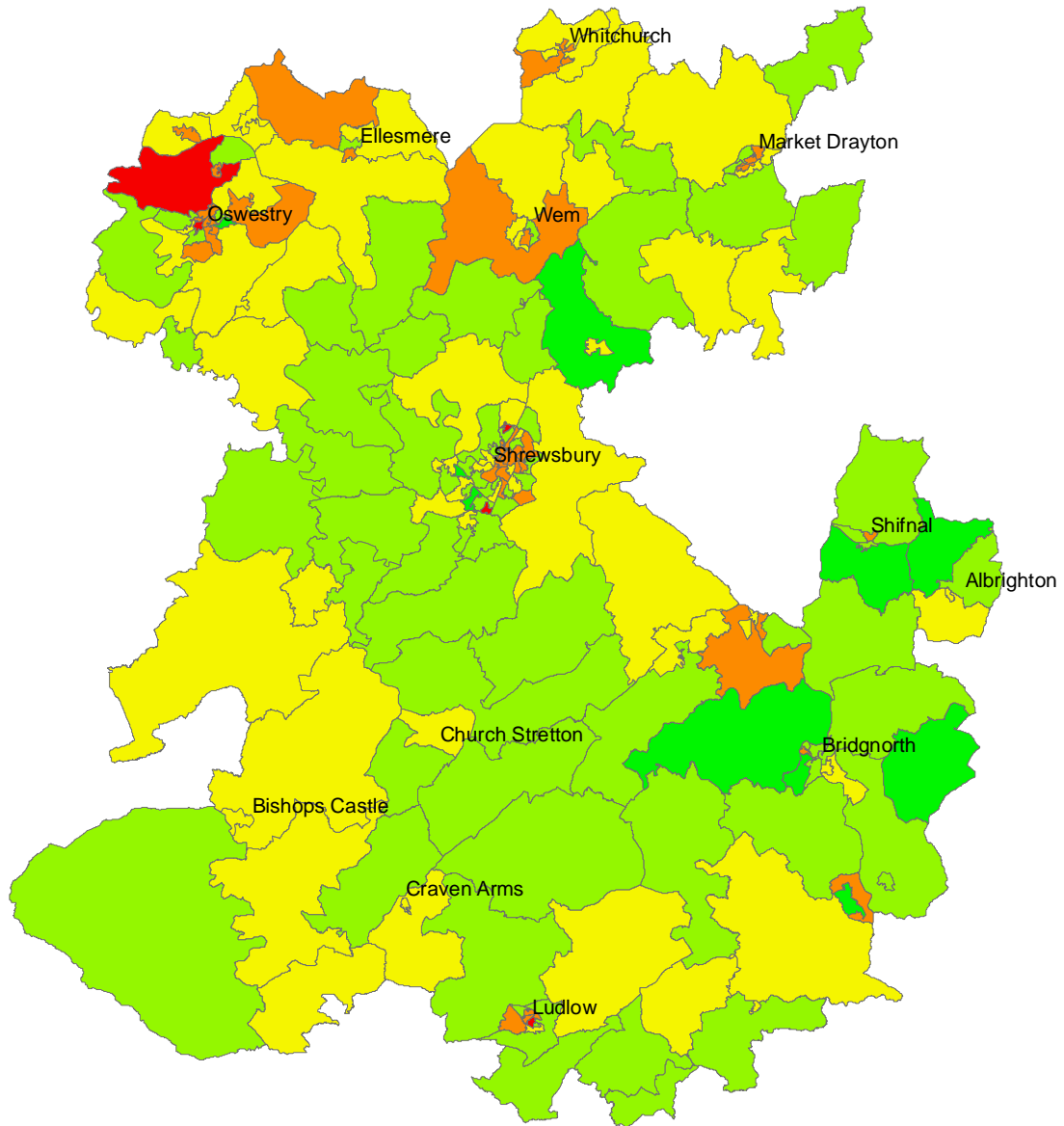
