Indices of Deprivation 2015 for Lower Super Output Areas in Shropshire: Crime Domain

About the Indices of Deprivation


The English Indices of Deprivation 2015 [IMD 2015] data is provided by the Department for Communities and Local Government (© Crown Copyright 2016). It provides an indication of deprivation at Lower Super Output Area [LSOA] level, a small area statistical geography.

The Crime Domain is one of several domains which focus on a particular type of deprivation. The scores from this domain contribute 9.3% towards the overall IMD 2015.

For the Crime Domain, all of the 32,844 LSOAs in England have been given a national ranking, with 1 being the most deprived LSOA. The LSOAs have also been divided, based on their rankings, into ten groups or Deciles with Decile 1 containing the 10% most deprived LSOAs in England.

Shropshire's LSOAs


Shropshire Unitary Authority has 193 LSOAs which are spread across nine of the ten national Deciles, with 17.1% of LSOAs belonging to Deciles 2 to 5. As the graph below shows, 2 LSOAs fall within the 20% most deprived LSOAs for this domain.

LSOAs within the Council Areas

Shropshire Unitary Authority can be divided into three areas (North, Central and South). Whilst each area contains a similar number of LSOAs (68 in North, 61 in Central and 64 in South) and all areas have LSOAs falling within a wide range of Deciles, the following chart highlights that, for the Crime domain, the Central Area has the largest number of LSOAs in the most deprived 50% of LSOAs nationally.

Most Deprived LSOAs in Shropshire

- Looking at the top ten most deprived LSOAs in Shropshire for the Crime Domain, five of the top 10 are located within Shrewsbury.
- Other LSOAs in the top 10 are also located within Shropshire's main towns, in Oswestry, Ludlow and Market Drayton.
- Two of the highest ranking Shrewsbury LSOAs cover the town centre and Castlefields area of Shrewsbury.
