NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION & COMING INTO OPERATION OF PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981

THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (FP 11 (PART) & FP 12 (PART) PARISH OF KEMBERTON) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2023.

On 11th January 2024, The Shropshire Council (the "Council") confirmed the above named order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 and section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981.

The effect of the order as confirmed is to divert

That part of FP 11 leaving Point A on the Order map at grid reference SJ 7299 0442 running in a general south easterly direction to a fence line then continuing in the general south easterly direction then ESE direction to a kissing gate at point B on the Order map at grid reference SJ 7311 0437. An approximate distance of 137 metres with a natural surface throughout **onto a line** leaving point A on the Order map at grid reference SJ 7299 0442, running in a general ESE, south easterly then ENE direction to re-join the Definitive line of FP 11 at a kissing gate at point B on the Order map at grid reference SJ 7311 0437. An approximate distance of 153 metres with a width of 2 metres on a natural surface throughout its length.

That part of FP 12 leaving point C on the Order map at grid reference SJ 7300 0442 running in a general SSW direction to point D on the Order map at grid reference SJ 7300 0441. A total distance of approximately 9 metres **onto a line** leaving point C on the Order map at grid reference SJ 7300 0442 running in a general WSW direction on a natural surface to a kissing gate then re-joining FP 11 at point A on the Order map at grid reference SJ 7299 0442. A total distance of approximately 10 metres with a width of 2 metres throughout.

Shropshire Council certify that the order becomes operative on 19th October 2023 but if a person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 11th January 2024 make an application to the High Court.
