The above named order made on 1st February 2024, by the Shropshire Council ("the Council") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 and section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, will

divert The full width of that part of the Footpath 57 from Point B on the Order Map grid reference SO 6763 8321 running through an arable field in a general northerly direction to the boundary fence of Ribley. From here it runs in a general NNW direction across grassland land before meeting the county road at Point C grid reference SO 6760 8336. A distance of approximately 165 metres.

onto a line From a gate at Point A on the Order Map grid reference SO 6758 8335, running in a general SSE direction. The footpath will then turn in a westerly direction following the current fence line of the property before turning southwest. It will then continue in a southerly direction along the western edge of the property curtilage before turning to the southeast to meet a gate on the southern property boundary grid reference SO 6759 8330. The footpath will continue into the adjacent field and will turn SSW towards the western edge of this field, following the field edge in a SSE direction before turning southeast to connect with the existing line of Footpath 57 at Point B on the Order Map grid reference SO 6763 8321. A total distance of approximately 194 metres with a width of 2 metres throughout.
